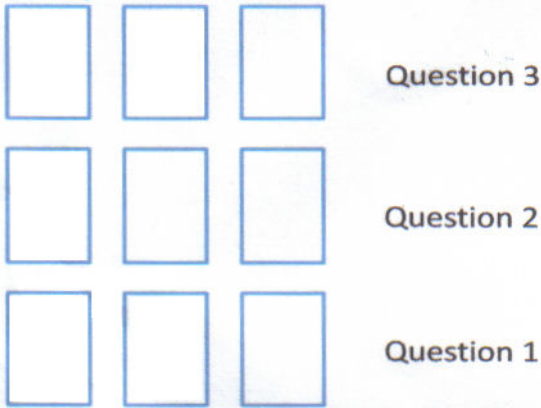


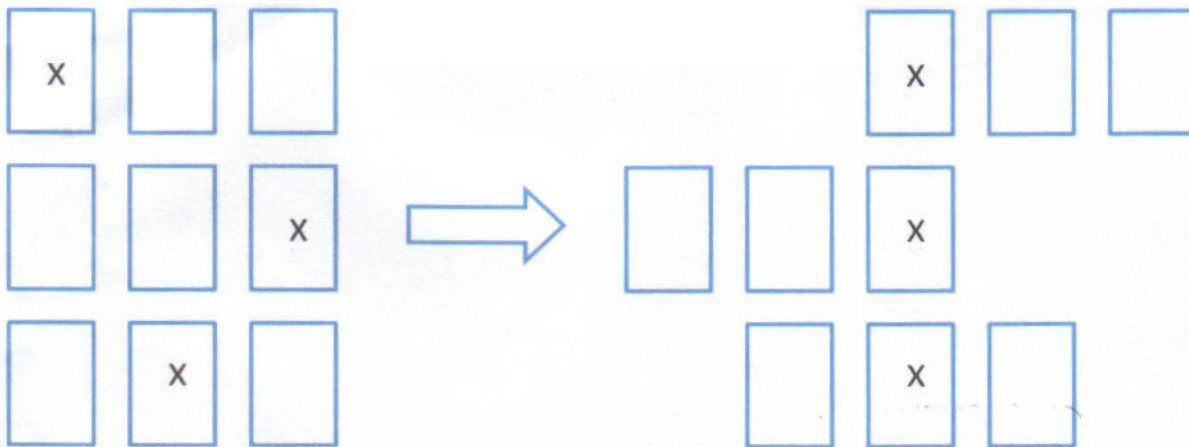
Three Questions – Variation

This is a variation on Mary's three questions spread. It works best with a completely reversible deck. Ask the querent to think of three questions. These must be yes or no questions and cannot be circular.

Begin to lay out the cards:



Have the querent choose one card from each row. Line these up on the table (see below). These cards are the answers to the questions. The simple answer is if it's upright, the answer is yes, and if it's reversed, the answer is no.



Read the answer card first, then the cards to the left and right.

Cards on the left of the answer card: These are things needed before things will happen or inputs that the querent needs to think about before making a decision. These cards could also represent things in the past that have played into the present situation.

Cards on the right of the answer card: These are things that may result from the situation or are unintended consequences.
